This month I am showing 14 of my 2010 and older collages at the downtown branch of the Savings Bank of Walpole. The exhibit includes six medium sized abstractions created from selected images from printed sources. (principally auction catalogues and calendars). Six additional collages are from my collection of Composite Poetry which go back to 2000 and 2001. Each of these poems was created from an individual issue of Newsweek magazine over the course

of a year and a half. There are over 75 poems in all; each composed from words and text phrases found in one issue only. The remaining two works are mixed media assemblages completed last year. The show runs through April.
